Being an Executive Director of a non-profit agency is a most rewarding and very challenging role. I can't imagine doing this without the expertise, advice, and support of the Board.

Today I say good-bye to the only board member on Greenleaf's board that has served this agency longer than I have been here. Don Pavlik, Senior Vice President at PNC Bank has served Greenleaf since 2012 and done so admirably. Don has served both as the Board Treasurer (two times), Board President, and Board Vice President. Interestingly, Don served as the Board President relatively early in his Board service and then jumped right back into a Treasurer's role after serving as the Board President.

Greenleaf has been through some trying times at the agency since I have been here, and we have had to make some difficult decisions. We have weathered the loss of significant funding over the years, survived terminating a defined pension plan which required refinancing the agency debt, come through a cyberattack which not only encrypted our files, but also our back up files, and of course found our way through COVID.

Don's expertise as a banker, his ability to keep the best interests of the agency in the forefront of his mind, and his other significant community involvement have been key to the success of this agency. ## Greenleaf's New Program! The Substance Use Prevention Education Resource (SUPER)

We all know that not everyone who has a negative consequence of drug or alcohol use, such as a DUI, has an actual, diagnosable substance abuse disorder. Greenleaf will soon have a new program to help prevent those who may be experiencing some negative consequences of substance misuse from developing a substance abuse disorder. The program is funded by the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board (ADM).

The Substance Use Prevention Education Resource (SUPER) will be a three-hour prevention education program designed to provide education and skills to participants that will reduce their risk and increase their overall wellness. Sessions will include information regarding the impacts of drugs and alcohol, personal values, the eight dimensions of wellness, low risk drinking guidelines, and community resources.

Most referrals are expected to come from community courts and treatment providers. Participants must have a current AOD Assessment which indicates this level of intervention to be appropriate (ASAM.5).

The first session will take place on Tuesday, July 27 from 5:00-8:00 pm. Eight additional sessions will be offered from September through June 2022.
